




Planned Activities Topic Theme: 'Where the Forest Meets the Sea'

Snack times are 10.15am and 3.00pm.

	Morning Activity	Afternoon Activity	Additional info. / role play all week
Monday 2 nd August	Create Club's own rainforest inside! Use large rolls of paper and art materials to turn the classroom into a rainforest!	Make the Australian flag to add to our rainforest classroom or to take home.	
Tuesday 3 rd August	Create a collage of a rainforest using materials such as tissue paper, card and cut up magazines. Create plane tickets for the afternoon activity!	We are off on our own trip to Australia. We need to think about what we would need to bring and then it's time to board the plane! Children can be offered an in-flight snack! When we arrive in the Australian rainforest, what will we see?	Children can explore the continent of Australasia and the location of the Daintree rainforest.
Wednesday 4 th August	Junk modelling of a boat or a city. Make a snake using multiple lolly sticks stuck together at a 45-degree angle, to make a zig-zag shape.	Musical instruments-making the sound of the jungle and the jungle animals. Make a rain-shaker.	
Thursday 5 th August	Aboriginal style painting- (see additional info) and painting using pointillism. Use cotton buds and earthy/natural colours. Discussions about animals that habituate in Australia to offer inspiration for their paintings.	A walk in our own school forest. What can we see, hear and smell? What plants and animals can we see? Children will use laminated identification sheets to identify animals and minibeasts.	Children will explore some examples of aboriginal art and use outlines to fill with dots.
Friday 6 th August	Message in a bottle- using plastic bottles which can be decorated by the children with glue, sequins, glitter etc.	Kangaroo races! We will use sacks and aprons - the children will need to collect bean bags in their pouch!!

Planned Activities Topic Theme: Dinosaurs

	Morning Activity	Afternoon Activity	Additional info. / role play all week
Monday 9 th August	Make a Stegosaurus with playdough using pasta for the spikes.	Fossil hunt in the sand pit (fossils pre-made). Children can use old paintbrushes to brush off the sand like a palaeontologist would!	Make big dinosaur feet and decorate with wax crayons and brusho. We will make a trail with the feet for children to jump on!
Tuesday 10 th August	Get scientific and make an erupting lemon volcano! Have a guess at what you think we may use for this...!	Dinosaur dancing using the 'Bumpus Jumpus Dinosaurumpus' book. We will use 'Dinosaurumpus listen and move' game.	Spinner for game - this can be found in the dinosaur drawer!
Wednesday 11 th August	Make a dinosaur mask using half a paper plate! We will paint the paper plates first and cut out eye holes! We will then add horns for a triceratops using coloured card.	Make a dinosaur using fruit arranged on a paper plate or make dinosaur footprint cookies.	
Thursday 12 th August	Make your own dinosaur door hanger or bookmark. You could make a Diplodocus door hanger, but remember to give it a long neck and write your name on it!	Time to get imaginative and play in our role play shop - can you shop for a dinosaur's dinner? Are they a herbivore or a carnivore? Children will be able to use dinosaur fact sheets to learn about a dino's diet!	Let's play hide and seek the dinosaurs in the forest!
Friday 13 th August	Have a go at making your own 3D dinosaur!	Let's get messy! Cut out a dinosaur and use your painted hands to make spikes on it's back!	Photocopies out of paper dinosaur book for morning activity. Pets as Therapy Dogs visit at 10am




Planned Activities Topic Theme: Space

	Morning Activity	Afternoon Activity	Additional info. /Role play all week
Monday 16 th August	This morning we are going to use junk modelling to make planets and spaceships. We will then make a large sun as a group, using wax crayons and yellow brushol!	Create a crescent moon and stars hanging mobile. Bake some cheesy stars, yum!	Make a space station, keyboard, chairs to sit in, tv screen.
Tuesday 17 th August	Create a whirling galaxy using black card and wax crayons of different colours.	Let's create a giant solar system on the field! Children can use balls and hoops to create the solar system on the field. Some children might then want to paint the planets on A3 paper to take home.	Children imagine to be astronauts or aliens whizzing around the solar system!
Wednesday 18 th August	Make pretend ice-creams using cupcake cases of different colours (to look like the scoops), stick onto paper ice cream cones.	Role play ice cream stand, using the ice-creams the children have made in the morning.	
Thursday 19 th August	Make an astronaut face mask using elastic. Can you write a short story about the astronaut's trip to space? What do you think they saw? Why were they floating around? Could we write a story collaboratively? Pretend to be weightless outside - what do you think it feels like to be in space?!	Science experiment (gravity). We are going to fill up one plastic bottle and leave one empty (same size bottles). We will make predictions about which one we think will hit the ground first! Let the experiment begin! We will then watch some videos about space and do a space quiz.	We will also explore male and female astronauts and read some facts about them! Decorate the plastic bottles to use in our experiment - think about how your design may change the variables of the experiment.
Friday 20 th August	Make your own colourful rocket on a straw and fly round the room!	Make some star and planet pictures using black card and glitter to create a solar system.	Pets as Therapy Dogs visit at 10am



Planned Activities Topic Theme: 'The Hungry Caterpillar'

	Morning Activity	Afternoon Activity	Additional info. /Role play all week
Monday 23 rd August	Restaurant role play time! Children can create healthy menus and then the classroom can be turned into a restaurant! Can you make some food out of play dough?	Use playdough for kitchen role play activity, as well as pots, pans etc.	
Tuesday 24 th August	Create sections on a paper plate and then create the different stages of the lifecycle of a butterfly. Eggs- white plasticine. Caterpillar- drawn on using felt tip or paint. Chrysalis- use green paper and draw a twig/branch. Butterfly- use a peg, paper and pipe cleaners.	Go on a mini beast hunt in the forest area, can we find any caterpillars? Will we see any butterflies? Before we head outside we will learn about where to look for caterpillars!	Paint symmetrical butterflies.
Wednesday 25 th August	Make a paper chain hungry caterpillar using green and red card/paper and stick-on googly eyes.	Build a bug hotel using twigs and other outdoor materials. You could use cardboard tubes to make the structure.	Insects in a tray with leaves and branches and bark. Add lego or duplo to make bug hotels!
Thursday 26 th August	Make fruit smoothies - please let us know of any new allergies that we are not already aware of. Can you use your fruit to make a butterfly or caterpillar?	Team game time! Play a healthy eating version of duck, duck, goose eg) grape, grape, melon!! Fruit salad parachute game.
