



Safeguarding Code of Conduct for all Users

We expect all staff, volunteers, committee members and all parent/carers using the club to support us in our Safeguarding Code of Conduct by requesting you:

- Treat all children with respect and dignity
- Acknowledge that the children's welfare and safety is paramount at all times
- Always act in a professional way and do not accept bullying, swearing or other disruptive behaviour
- Communicate effectively and professionally, avoiding inappropriate language, remarks and gestures
- Be aware of and follow Club's policies and procedures
- Listen to and act upon any disclosures, allegations or concerns of child abuse or the welfare of children
- Adhere to the Club's mobile phone policy, which states:
"In the interest of safeguarding, we ask all parents/carers and visitors NOT to use their phones or other mobile devices on Club premises. There are 'no mobile phones' posters on the school site and parents are frequently reminded in school and Club newsletters about this policy. Taking of photographs by parents/carers or visitors is Strictly prohibited. If a parent would like to have a photograph of their child involved in an activity, they can ask a member of staff to take one using the club camera."
